Dear Parents/Caregivers,

On Friday the 23rd of November 2018 selected Y5/6 pupils from Rooms 7, 9 and 10 will be representing Stanley Bay School at the Onepoto School Cultural Festival. This is a great opportunity for our children to perform their Kapa Haka in front of a large audience.

We will be travelling to Onepoto school by bus, leaving school at approximately 11.00am and returning to school at 1.30pm.

We will require a small number of adults per class to assist the teachers with supervision during our visit. Parent helpers will travel with us on the bus and will be expected to supervise a small group of children whilst the group is attending the cultural festival. Please note we cannot accommodate preschoolers on this trip.

The cost for this trip is \$7 and can be paid via kindo by using the following steps:

- log into your kindo account
- select Trips
- select "Onepoto Cultural Festival"
- select the circle which has the initial of the correct child participating in this event. THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT to ensure that there is no confusion of pupils at our end.
- you will then be prompted to answer permission and parent help questions
- continue with payment as per normal

Additional information:

- There will be food being sold at the festival. However, children from SBS will need to bring their own packed lunch. No food is to be purchased.
- Children will go to the festival in a Kapa Haka Uniform provided by the school.
- As we are going to be performing on the outdoor stage please check your children wear sunblock.
