STANLEY BAY SCHOOL COVID PROTECTION FRAMEWORK

As we head into Term 2, we remain fully committed to providing the best possible education under the Covid Protection Framework (CPF). As you will be aware, we are currently in the orange setting of the CPF. Therefore, please read the information below carefully as it details school operations to mitigate risk to our tamariki, staff and community.

We will continue to be guided by the Ministry of Health and Ministry of Education to ensure we manage risk and keep our children, staff and community safe.

PUBLIC HEALTH MEASURES

The school will continue to observe public health measures including but not limited to basic hygiene, ventilation and management of student and staff sickness.

HYGIENE

Face Coverings

When indoors:

- Year 4,5 and 6 students are strongly encouraged to wear a mask
- Staff are strongly encouraged to wear a mask
- Parents are required to wear a mask when onsite

Physical Distancing

- Physical distancing is not required
- No indoor or outdoor capacity limits

Drinking fountains

- Drinking fountains not in use

Ventilation

- Windows and doors open to minimum 5cm
- Classes will take outdoor breaks every hour

TEACHING AND LEARNING

Physical and cultural activities

- Physical and cultural activities will observe public health measures
- Curriculum related activities involving more than one class can go ahead both indoors and outdoors

Music and singing

- Physical distancing of 1m where practicable
- Instruments will not be shared
- Singing will take place in well-ventilated spaces

PARENTS ON SITE

- Parents and caregivers are permitted onsite. When coming on site parents must sign in at the office, sanitise and are required to wear a mask
- Parents may enter the school buildings but are not permitted in the classrooms

- Events will take place in well ventilated areas eg. hall

HOME LEARNING

Home learning will be provided for;

- students self-isolating or awaiting test results
- children who have complex medical needs who are learning from home following advice of a health professional

DROP OFF AND PICK UP PROCEDURE AT ORANGE

The drop off and pick procedure below will remain in place.

We have found this procedure to be beneficial in growing independence and resilience in our younger children and strongly encourage you to continue to use a 'kiss and go' approach.

Year 3 - 6 Rooms 4,5,6,7,8,9	8:30 - 9:00am Students are not to arrive before 8.30am and can use the Russell Street gates or the Glen Road gates. Parents are to remain outside the gates. Teachers will be waiting in the classrooms.	3:00 - 3:15pm Meet your child at either the Russell Street gates or the Glen Road gates. Seniors, with or without younger siblings, are still permitted to walk home unaccompanied.
Year 0 - 2 Rooms 1,2,10,11,12,13	8.50 - 9.00am Students are not to arrive before 8.50am and must use only the Russell Street gates. Parents are to remain outside the school, identify the relevant teacher on the court and send students to join their class. In the case of bad weather the teachers will wait on: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • R1,2,12 – Senior Deck • R10, 11 and 12 – Junior Deck 	2:55 - 3:00pm Teachers will bring students out to the court on Russell Street and release them on sight of their parents/carers. In the case of bad weather the teachers will wait in the undercover area by the office. Juniors may wait with their teacher for older siblings.
